Times Tables

By the end of Year 3, children should be able to recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables. (2, 5 & 10 in Year 2) Please encourage your child to practise these daily at home too.

Every child brought home their handwriting pack before half term. Your child is to work through this in their own time and ensure that it is completed to a high standard. We will continue to work on this every day in class too.
